Allergen Training Procedure

I. Purpose:

To protect the public from accidental food-allergen reactions. ICPHD will require documentation of allergen training during routine food inspections. Allergen training educates food service staff members on how to safely make and serve food to the public to reduce the incidence of allergic reactions.

II. Policy:

Require proof of proper allergen training at each routine inspection from the appropriate staff.

III. Procedure:

During each routine inspection, the health authority will request documentation of allergen training from the appropriate staff. Documentation may be produced in either paper or electronic format. Proof or absence of documentation will be documented in the inspection form under item 56, *Employee Training*: “Allergen training as required.”
