

NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX INCREASE FOR IROQUOIS COUNTY

- I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for Iroquois County for 2022 payable 2023 will be held on December 8, 2022 at 10 A.M. at the Clifford Bury Administrative Center in the Iroquois County Board Room, 1001 E. Grant St., Watseka, IL 60970.

- II. The corporate and special property taxes extended or abated for 2021 payable 2022 were \$5,219,961.62.

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2022 payable 2023 are \$5,936,858.00. This represents a 13.73% increase over the previous year.

- III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2021 payable 2022 were \$-0-.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2022 payable 2023 are \$-0-. This represents a 0% increase from the previous year.

- IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2021 payable 2022 were \$5,219,961.62. The estimated total property taxes levied for 2022 payable 2023 are \$5,936,858.00. This represents a 13.73% increase over the previous year.
