Notice of Proposed Property Tax Increase for Iroquois County.

I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for Iroquois County for 2023 will be held on December 7, 2023 at 11:00AM at the Iroquois County Administrative Center, 1001 E. Grant St. Watseka, IL 60970.

II. The corporate and special property taxes extended or abated for 2022 were \$5,684,052.43.

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2023 are \$6,149,668.00. This represents a 8.19% increase over the previous year.

III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2022 were \$-0-.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2023 are \$-0-. This represents a 0% increase from the previous year.

IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2022 were \$5,684,052.43. The estimated total property taxes levied for 2023 are \$6,149,668.00. This represents a 8.19% increase over the previous year.
